EU Login - Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA)

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1. Introduction

Delegates Portal will require EU Login Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) to authenticate users, aiming to enhance the security of user accounts and access to sensitive information.

Access to the platform will require an EU Login along with <u>two types</u> of authentication factors, making it significantly harder for unauthorised users to gain access.

From now on, there will be an additional layer of authentication beyond the password, defined as the **first verification factor**.

The **second verification factor** requires users to provide a second piece of information, such as a unique code from a mobile application, a token, or a text message to verify their identity and grant access to the platform. This process enhances security by adding an extra step that is more challenging for unauthorised users to bypass.

Delegates Portal users are required to have two different accounts to access the system:

- 1) **a Delegates Portal account**, specific to the platform and used to provide personalised access based on the user's role, permissions, and preferences;
- 2) an EU Login account, for the enhanced authentication mechanism.

Currently, there are three categories of users:

- 1) Users with an active Delegates Portal <u>and</u> EU Login account;
- Users with an active Delegates Portal account who do <u>not yet</u> have an EU Login account;
- 3) New users requesting access to Delegates Portal.

2. Timeline

We plan the transition to the new scheme in two phases, tailored to ensure seamless integration with EU Login MFA.

2.1. Phase 1

This will start from **mid-September 2023** and will concern local, system and support **administrators** of the Delegates Portal.

2.2. Phase 2

This will start from **mid-October 2023** and will concern all other accounts on the platform. The transition should be complete by the end of 2023.

This documentation provides a detailed description of the steps required to log in, for the three categories of users in each phase.

3. Logging into Delegates Portal

Depending on the active phase we are in, Delegates Portal login page will be gradually modified to shift to the exclusive use of EU Login.

From **mid-October 2023**, <u>all remaining users</u> will have to use the EU Login MFA for logging into Delegates Portal. Consequently, Delegates Portal login page will stop displaying the two options. It will show only the EU Login interface with MFA enabled.

Click on the EU LOGIN button and follow the next steps:

You will be redirected to the EU Login authentication form.

3.1. Scenario A: Users with an active Delegates Portal and an EU Login account

If you have an **EU Login** and a **Delegates Portal account**, proceed by writing your **e-mail** address or unique identifier and then, click on **NEXT**:

4) At this point, you will be required to choose the preferred verification method for the second factor from the list by clicking on the down-arrow:

- 4) Choose the preferred verification method for the second factor, for example, Mobile Phone
- + SMS option:

6) The input you need to provide for identity validation will vary based on your chosen verification method for the second factor.

If you chose the **Mobile Phone + SMS** option, you will receive an SMS containing a code on your mobile phone. This code should be entered into the EU Login authentication option.

7) You should now be logged into your Delegates Portal account.

3.2. <u>Scenario B</u>: Users with an active Delegates Portal account without an EU Login account

If you already have an active **Delegates Portal account**, but you do <u>not</u> have an **EU Login account**, you are required to:

- Create an EU Login account;
- Link the two accounts together.

Creating an EU Login account

To create a new EU Login account, click either:

• On the *Create an account* link, once the system redirects you from the initial page to the EU Login authorisation form:

Enter your e-mail address or unique identifier

Linking your EU Login account to your Delegates Portal account

After successfully creating an EU Login account, the system will automatically require you to link your Delegates Portal account with an EU Login account.
